

NADMAJAIWIN NADMAJAISUUCH NEMASKA JUSTICE COMMITTEE

MEANING OF THE NAME:

The meaning of the Nemaska Nadmajaiwin Nadmajaisuuch logo is about community collaboration in the spirit of restorative justice or Miinwatsiiun Nadmajaiwin. When a crime or wrong-doing is committed there is a victim, an offender and the community. All are affected. Restoration happens when the affected members reconcile, or right the wrong. The three persons embracing represent the victim, offender and the community.

THE PURPOSE OF THE NEMASKA NADMAJAIWIN NADMAJAISUUCH:

- **1- PROMOTE** and maintain **social peace** and **harmony** in our community.
- **2- HELP** administer justice using culturally adapted approaches, which place greater emphasis on healing victims, offenders, families and the community,

and that deal with the underlying causes of problems and offending behaviour.

- **3- OFFER alternatives** or complements to the mainstream justice system while including the people that have been affected by the crime or conflict.
- 4- ENCOURAGE a social reaction to crime and criminal behaviour that favors accountability, reparation, restoration of balance and the re-establishment of relations among affected individuals.
- 5- PROMOTE understanding and respect of laws, socially acceptable behaviours, cultural values, and traditions.
